- Proposals:

First Grade has a proposal for Build Up phonics books. They have a set of 25 in each class and there are 30 students per classroom. They would like to order the books in black and white and allow the students to take them home to practice reading. The cost would be \$985. They are purchased in cases of 25 therefore, they would need 5 cases. After further discussion we would like to counter this proposal and see if first grade would be willing to

send home the color books and just order one additional case of books to subsidize the additional 5 students they have in each class. This cost would be \$197. Lastly, an additional option would be if they are willing to make photocopies of the books to send home. The books only have a few pages. This would eliminate the fear of having them being lost or damaged at home.

Kindergarten has a proposal for a copy machine that can print on construction paper. Last year this proposal came up and was determined that our school needed additional T.V.'s and the funds would be best put towards those. Kinder will consider lower price options and we can re visit this at the next meeting.
